From the Pastor's Desk

Sr. Emilie Ann Palladino served our parish for many years as director of spiritual formation. She led RCIA, bible studies, organized and led innumerable sessions of Impact, taught the pre-baptism preparation class for parents and godparents. She interviewed all the English speaking parents for baptism for many years which adds up to a lot of people indeed. Sister also loved to write and supplied reflections for the bulletin over the years as well as in other places.

But it was in the past six years of prolonged illness and treatments that she not just taught spirituality but exemplified it for those of us who witnessed it. She retained a spirit of gratitude through it all, even the most painful and debilitating treatments, I never heard her complain or whine. My illness was minor league stuff in comparison but she constantly checked in on me, and how I was doing. This of course, was a living out of her faith, especially the cross and resurrection of Jesus. Her deep devotion to Our Lady (she was a sister of Notre Dame) sustained her also.

She loved Our Lady of Grace, this was where she felt at home, loved and supported. As late as Palm Sunday she made the effort to be here for mass. When the doctors (and she was so appreciative of her doctors) told her she was going to hospice care and time was running out she called me, it was the Sunday night before she died and our last extended conversation. She wanted me to be sure to tell everyone at OLG how thankful she was for all the prayers, love and support and how much she had been sustained by that. Today's 9:30 am Mass will be in celebration of her life and her service here, God grant rest to her gentle soul.

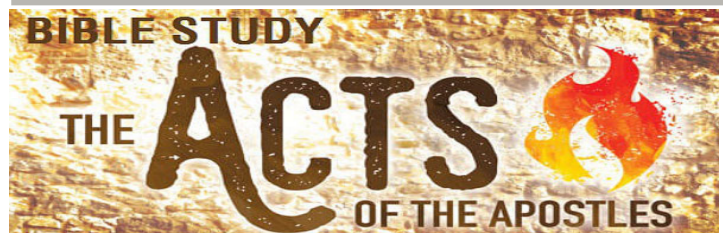

Mensaje del Párroco

Sor Emilie Ann Palladino sirvió en nuestra parroquia por muchos años como directora de formación espiritual. Ella estuvo a cargo de RICA, estudios bíblicos, organizando y dirigiendo innumerables sesiones del grupo Impacto, dirigió las clases de preparación pre bautismal para padres y padrinos. Hizo las entrevistas de todos los padres de habla inglés para los bautismos durante muchos años, que se suma a una gran cantidad de personas de hecho. Al a hermana también le gustaba escribir reflexiones para el boletín a lo largo de los años, así como en otros lugares.

Pero fue en los últimos seis años de su enfermedad y tratamientos que ella no sólo nos enseñó la espiritualidad, pero nos dio su ejemplo prolongado. Ella conservó un espíritu de gratitud a pesar de todo, incluso entre los tratamientos más dolorosos y debilitantes, nunca la escuche lamentarse o quejarse. Mi enfermedad fue cosa de ligas menores en comparación a lo de ella, pero ella constantemente estuvo al tanto de mí, para saber cómo yo estaba. Esto, por supuesto, fue como ella vivió su fe, especialmente la cruz y la resurrección de Jesús. Su profunda devoción a la Virgen (era una hermana de la comunidad de Nuestra Señora) la sostuvo también.

Ella amó mucho nuestra comunidad de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia, este era el lugar donde se sentía como en casa, amada y apoyada. Tan reciente como el Domingo de Ramos ella hizo el esfuerzo de estar aquí en una de nuestras misas. Cuando los médicos (y estaba tan agradecido por sus médicos) le dijeron que iba a cuidados paliativos y el tiempo se agotaba me llamó, fue el domingo por la noche antes de morir y nuestra última conversación extendida. Ella quería asegurarse que yo les dijera a todos en nuestra parroquia lo agradecida que estaba por todas las oraciones, el amor, el apoyo, y lo mucho que había sido sostenida por eso. Ahora domingo, 6 de mayo en la misa de 9:30 am celebraremos la vida y el servicio de Sor Emilie Ann aquí en nuestra iglesia. Que Dios le conceda el descanso eterno a su alma gentil.
