From the Pastor's Desk

The Jewish feast of Pentecost celebrated the giving of the law to Moses at Sinai.



Jesus left us His Spirit more than a set of laws. We celebrate the gift of the Spirit today through the sacrament of Confirmation, the sacrament of the Spirit. I always think of the Spirit as an energy, an impulse outward. The Spirit moves us always out of ourselves and our self-interest and preoccupations, out to the other, to the neighbor, to the enemy, to the ends of the earth. The Spirit pushes out our boundaries, leaves no one outside. With the Spirit there is no "us" and "them" just us, beloved forgiven children of a good father. This Spirit drove the first apostles out from their locked doors in Jerusalem to preach the risen Jesus to the crowds gathered for the festival in a way that all understood despite their different languages and origins. In Galatians Paul says the fruits of the Spirit are "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law" He might have added also that no law can achieve such, only the gift and action of the Spirit. We pray for an outpouring of those gifts on our candidates for confirmation and on all of us as we celebrate this Pentecost.

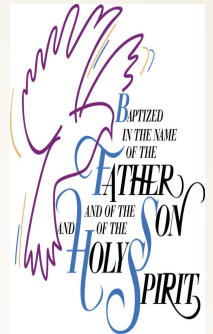

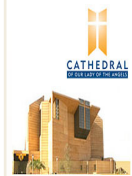
OLG School News

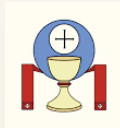

Moisés en el Monte Sinaí. Jesús nos dejó su Espíritu más que un conjunto de leyes. Hoy celebramos los dones del Espíritu Santo a través del sacramento de la confirmación, el sacramento del Espíritu. Siempre pienso en el Espíritu como una energía, un impulso hacia el exterior. El Espíritu nos mueve siempre fuera de nosotros mismos y nuestros propios intereses y preocupaciones, hacia otras personas, hacia el vecino, hacia el enemigo, y hasta los confines de la tierra. El Espíritu empuja fuera de nuestras fronteras, no deja a nadie afuera. Con el espíritu no hay “nosotros” y ni “ellos” sólo nosotros, criaturas amadas y perdonada por un padre bueno. Este Espíritu condujo a los primeros apóstoles a que salieran fuera de sus puertas cerradas en Jerusalén a predicar a Jesús resucitado a las multitudes y se reunieron para la fiesta de una manera que todos entendieron a pesar de sus diferentes lenguas y orígenes. En Gálatas Pablo dice que los frutos del Espíritu son “amor, alegría, paz, paciencia, benignidad, bondad, fidelidad, mansedumbre, dominio de sí mismo.
