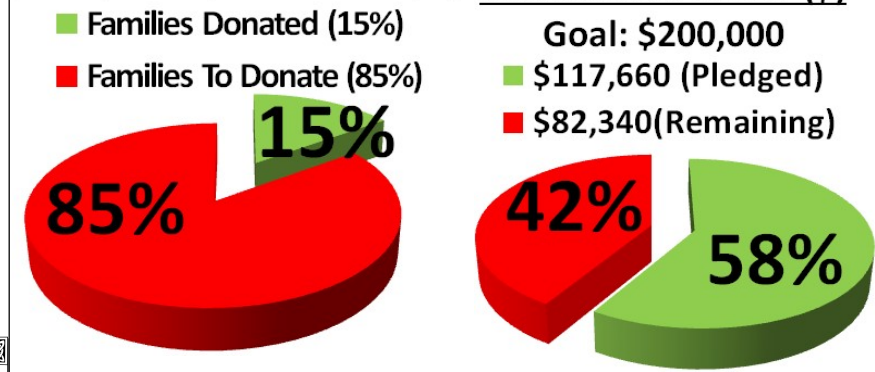

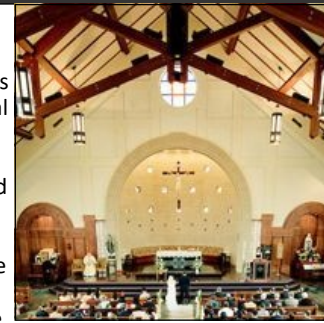


CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (LWC)

TIMELY DRESS

As the weather slowly warms up outside, we need to be mindful of our way of dress for Mass. Our worship in both our internal disposition and our care to dress modestly and well for the Lord, is an example to one another. Our dress should reflect the environment of where we are: if we are at the beach then we should dress for the beach; likewise, since we are coming to Mass, we need to give a reflection of true praise to God by a more formal way of dressing than our everyday wear; by choosing not to wear shorts, tank tops, or other forms of revealing clothes to Mass! We are not emphasizing a dress code, but simply to dress appropriately for Mass! Thank you for your responsibility in this area and your example to all ages. P.S. "With air conditioning in the Church, if you are wearing very little clothing you might catch a cold".
