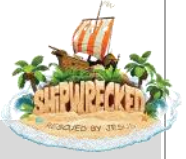

POPE FRANCIS ~ MORNING MEDITATION IN THE CHAPEL OF  
DOMUS SANCTAE MARTHAЕ: Thursday, 5 February 2015

In today's Gospel passage, Jesus calls his disciples and sends them to take the Gospel and "proclaim that all should repent" (Mark 6: 12). It is He who calls. He called them and gave them powers; in the vocation of the disciples, the Lord gives power: the power to drive away the impure spirits to free, to heal. This is the power that Jesus gives. In fact, the power that he gives is not to maneuver or make big business... He does so with clear advice: **Go to the community! For the journey you will take nothing. Go in poverty!**

The Gospel is so rich and so strong that it does not need to make big companies to be announced. **The Gospel must be announced in poverty. The true shepherd is the one who goes like Jesus: poor, to announce the Gospel, with that power.**

**When the Gospel is guarded with this simplicity, with this poverty, we see clearly that salvation is not a theology of prosperity but it is a gift, the same gift that Jesus had received to give it.**

Look at that very beautiful scene in the synagogue, when Jesus presents himself to his own. He said: "I was sent to bring salvation, to bring the good news to the poor, to the prisoners liberation, to the blind the gift of sight. The liberation to all those who are oppressed and to announce the year of grace, the year of joy ". This is precisely the purpose of the evangelical announcement, without so many worldly and strange things. This is how Jesus sends.

And what does the disciples do, that is, what is his pastoral program? Simply to cure, heal, raise, free, drive away demons - this is the simple program! That coincides with the mission of the Church which is to **heal the wounds of the heart, open doors, free, preach that God is good, that God forgives everything, that God is father, that God is tender, and that God always waits.**

In the parallel story in the Gospel of Luke (chapter 10), the disciples return "with joy, saying, 'Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.'" (v 17) They were indeed happy because this power of Jesus, done with simplicity, with poverty, with love, gave a good result.



The very phrase addressed to Jesus by the happy disciples, according to the Gospel, explains everything to us. They say: "We have done this, and this, and this, and this ...". So, after having listened to them, Jesus closes his eyes and says: "I was watching Satan fall from heaven..." (v 18) These words reveal the struggle of the Church: it is true, we should get help and create aid organizations, for the Lord gives us gifts for this, but, when we forget our mission: when we forget poverty, we forget apostolic zeal and we put hope in these means, the Church slowly slips into an NGO and becomes a fine organization: powerful but not evangelical, because that spirit is lacking, that poverty, that power to heal.

When they return, Jesus brings the disciples to rest a little, to have a day in the country, to eat sandwiches with a drink. In short, the Lord wants to spend a little time together to celebrate! Together they talk about the mission just completed. But Jesus does not say to them: "You're great! Now let's plan things better for the next excursion!" He limits himself to recommending: "when you do all the things which are commanded you, say, 'We are unworthy slaves; we have done only that which we ought to have done.'" (Luke, 17: 10).

In these words, the Lord described the profile of an apostle. Indeed, what would be the greatest praise for an apostle? The answer: "He was a labourer for the Kingdom. He was a worker for the Kingdom." Precisely this is the highest praise, because he goes on Jesus' path of proclamation; he goes to heal, to safeguard, to proclaim these glad tidings and this year of grace. To enable the people to find the Father once again, to make peace in the peoples' hearts.

The most important things to Jesus, in proclaiming the Gospel: they are these, these small virtues. And then it is He, it is the Holy Spirit who does it all.

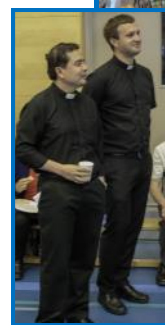

**Q:** My parents taught me I am worthy because I'm a child of God Almighty. We are all worthy just by the fact we were created in God's image... so I struggle to understand these words at the end of the Eucharistic prayer: "*Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof. . .*"

**A:** You are not the first person I've encountered who has been bothered by the implications of not being worthy. So, what are we saying when we utter those words?

The Catholic Church has always taught on universal goodness. The Church teaches a number of powerful truths related to human dignity. First, "man has been created 'in the image and likeness' of the Creator" (CCC, 1701). Further, "It is in Christ, Redeemer and Savior, that the divine image, disfigured in man by the first sin, has been restored to its original beauty and ennobled by the grace of God" (CCC, 1701). And third, "The divine image is present in every man (CCC, 1702).

The Church affirms that these incredible realities are true for all human beings, regardless of race, sex, or life experience. Every human being is created good. Every human being is fallen, wounded, scarred by sin. And every human has been redeemed by Jesus (though not every human being participates in this redemption). So yes, you are good. Yes, you are fallen. And yes, you have been redeemed. But does that make one "worthy"?

Before we get to that, a very important question arise here: where does "our" goodness come from? The Church teaches that all of our goodness comes from God. Not some - ALL. God is the Source of everything that is good in us. If we start claiming dignity or worth as our "own" apart from God, we will have begun to wander into a very dangerous trap.

C.S. Lewis, in his collection of essays, 'The Weight of Glory', writes: "The infinite value of each human soul is not a Christian doctrine. God did not die for man because of some value perceived in him. He loved us not because we are lovable, but because HE IS LOVE."

This is what St. Paul wrote in his letter to the Romans, "For Christ, while we were still helpless, yet died at the appointed time for the ungodly. Indeed, only with difficulty does one die for a just person, though perhaps for a good person one might even find courage to die. But God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us" (Romans 5:6-8). St. Paul is reminding us that God's love, not some intrinsic goodness on our part, is what drew God to us.

So you are completely correct in affirming the worth of every human being in relation to other human beings. But, at this particular moment of the Mass, we are not speaking of our worth in relation to other human beings. We are talking about our worth in comparison to God himself. In comparison to His infinity, we remain completely and utterly unworthy.

All of our goodness comes from God. Because of this, human dignity is something we can scarcely imagine. But this does not make us even close to becoming equals with God. And I think that this might be the source of your difficulty. We are so used to comparing our worth with other human beings (and being told, "no one is better than anyone else"), that we take the same comparisons and confidences into our relationship with God. But in comparison with God, I am literally "zero". I offer nothing. I am nothing. In comparison to His infinity, I remain completely and utterly unworthy.

Again, we are not talking about being worthy of just and honorable treatment by another human being. We are not talking about being worthy of respect and equality in the community in which we live. We are not talking about being worthy of the love of the people around us. We are talking about the assessment of whether or not we believe that God "owed it to us" that we deserved that He should die for us. We are talking about whether or not we deserved that God "emptied himself and took the form of a slave...[and] obediently accepted...death on a cross!" (Phil 2: 7-8) We are dangerously close to asserting that we are so worthy that The Lord of the Universe ought to humble himself to the point of becoming our food!

I am not worthy of that. God is so good however that he offers me this. Remember, pride is still the deadliest of the deadly sins. And pride that is simply dressed up as "self worth" remains deadly. In comparison with God, I am not worthy. And yet. His goodness desires to bridge the gap between his worthiness and our unworthiness, which is why we continue, "but only say the word and my soul shall be healed".



## Feast Day of Saints Anne and Joachim - July 26th

An ancient story dating to the first centuries of the Church's life recalls how Saints Anne & Joachim, like Abraham and Sarah, were scorned by their neighbors because they had no children. Years of longing did not weaken their trust in God, but grief eventually drove St. Joachim into the wilderness to fast and pray. St. Anne, remaining at home, dressed in mourning clothes and wept because she had no child of her own. Seeing her mistress distressed, a servant girl reminded Anne to put her trust in God. St. Anne washed her face, put on her bridal clothes and went to a garden to plead with God for a child. Angels appeared to St. Anne in her garden and St. Joachim in the desert, promising that, despite their old age, they would give birth to a child who would be known throughout the world. The new parents ran to meet one another at Jerusalem's Golden Gate, and with a kiss rejoiced in the new life which God had promised would be theirs. Sts. Anne and Joachim are powerful intercessors for all married couples, expectant mothers and married couples who are having difficulty conceiving, as well as all who have grown old.

St. Anne 9-day Novena is traditionally started on **July 17th** to **July 25th**. Copies of the Novena to St. Ann are available at Star of the Sea and Good Shepherd Churches.
