One day, I phoned asking to speak to Mr. Smith. A helpful and friendly lady answered and said, "I'm sorry, he doesn't live here anymore". Disappointed, I enquired further, "Do you happen to have his new number"? Cheerfully she replied, "Sure thing" and gave me the information. I quickly hung up and dialed the new number, only to hear a recording, "Thank you for calling Ocean View Cemetery".

Today's Readings are about Jesus as the giver of life. The Gospel consists of two related stories, with one inside the other, a typical feature of Mark's Gospel known as 'inclusion'.

In the first story, we see Jesus told the father of the little girl: "Do not be afraid, only believe," then He took the girl by the hand and commanded her to get up and was alive again. Then in the second story, we have a woman who had been hemorrhaging for 12 years. Nobody would come near her for fear that they would become ritually unclean and not allowed to enter the Temple to worship. This woman touched the hem of Jesus' cloak and she was instantly cured of her illness. It was her faith that saved her.

Both of these stories reveal Jesus as the source of life and healing. Today's First Reading also says "God did not make death and He does not delight in the death of the living. God created man for incorruption and made him in the image of His own eternity."

This is the goal of our lives: to know, to love and to share in His life forever. Yet all of us, in some way or another, are constantly in need of God's healing which will give us health in every aspect of our lives, and not just in our bodies.

"Do not be afraid" is a phrase that St. John Paul II used in one of his *Encyclicals* to put our trust in Jesus Christ. This phrase appears in the Bible 366 times, one for every day of the year, even for the leap year when we have 366 days.

Part of our healing is in the wholeness of our communities, a wholeness which is based on truth, love, compassion and a deep sense of justice for all. And this, too, is holiness, because God is an integral part of the wholeness.



Let us pray today to Jesus as Lord of life and ask Him to help us reach that level of health, wholeness and holiness to which He is calling us.
