A parishioner asked me to pray for him, for peace of mind and heart. However, I eventually realized that I was really being asked to pray that some awkward person in this parishioner's life might disappear! And only with that happening, that he would be able to have peace of mind and heart.

Certainly, we all want peace of mind and heart, but it has to be based on reconciliation which in turn is rooted in conversion and repentance.

When Jesus sent the twelve out to proclaim the Gospel, they preached repentance. Now we all know that repentance is central to the Gospel. But what does repentance mean? We usually identify it with some effort in self-improvement; making ourselves more patient and kind, less judgmental or selfish.

These efforts are indeed essential to repentance. But repentance is much larger and wider; and is as large as the mission of Christ. The mission of Christ is to reconcile all things to God and all people to one another.

... A young priest was replacing an old pastor of a small tightly-knit community after 30 years as their priest. The parishioners loved the old priest and found the change very difficult. One particular woman who had been very close to the previous pastor wanted nothing to do with the new priest.

She continuously stirred the pot of discontent within the parish. Within a very brief time a great deal of distrust and hurt had developed between this priest and his parishioner.

Now it was the practice that every year the pastor visits each parishioner in their own home. The thought of visiting this difficult woman terrified the priest. But one day her name came up as the next visit he had to do. He steeled himself, drove up to her house, paced back and forth in the front yard for courage, took deep breath and finally walked up the steps and knocked. No answer! GOOD! He could just leave his card and go away. . . but he thought he should knock again. Still, no answer, but heard a small sound inside which caused him to worry. Perhaps the woman had fallen or suffered a stroke! She might need

help! Kneeling down, he looked through the keyhole . . . only to see an eye looking back at him. Then from within, the woman said with a chuckle, "Well Father, I guess this is the first time that you and I have seen eye to eye." To which the priest responded, "Yes, and we had to get down on our knees to do it." *Fr. Joseph*

This is your opportunity to get together with folks who just want a chance to sing without the pressure of being in a church choir.

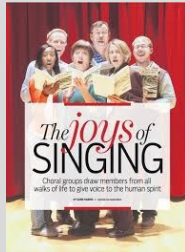
