Pastor's Corner

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

August 12, 2018

Dear Parishioners,

One of the very satisfying parts of my job as a parish priest is to assist couples who were married outside the Catholic Church to have their civil unions blessed in the Church. It means that once this "convalidation" takes place the couple, if they're both Catholic, or the one who is the Catholic, can now receive the Sacraments of Confession and Eucharist, and can once again take part in the fullest of ways in the sacramental life of the Church. Sometimes the couple are not aware of the consequences of being married by a civil official instead of a priest, and are surprised when they discover that they are not allowed to receive Holy Communion until they have their marriage blessed in the Church. It is a great joy when we can arrange to have this done, and so if there is anyone who needs this manner of pastoral care, please call the office and speak to myself or one of the other priests.

In relation to the above comments it is one of the Precepts of the Church that all Catholics must be married by a priest in order to have a valid marriage. Couples are required to take part in a marriage preparation program sponsored by the Archdiocese, and do the necessary paperwork to establish their freedom to marry, and then plan the ceremony with the parish priest. The normal requirement is 4 to 6 months notice so that all can be done in preparation for the marriage, and the cost related to the ceremony in the Church is minimal. The majority of funds expended on a wedding are related to the garments, flowers, photography, and reception, while the costs for parish, organist, and celebrant are small by comparison.

I sometimes hear "we couldn't afford to get married" which when translated actually means we couldn't afford the party, and then a brief civil ceremony is done. Let me assure anyone who has that idea, that a marriage in the Church can be celebrated without any undue expense, and the vows are exchanged before a priest and two witnesses with family and friends, which assures the Catholic party that this marriage was entered into in the midst of the Church community and before the Lord Himself as represented by the priest.

Parents need to teach their children that marriage is a holy relationship, sanctified by Christ and His Church, and must be entered into in a manner suitable to its sacred character. Every baptized Catholic has the right to be married in the Church, even if the practice of faith is weak, and by the same token, every baptized Catholic is obliged to be married in the Church, even if the practice of faith is weak. The Lord promises His grace when the sacred vows of marriage are exchanged in his holy presence.

If anyone is getting engaged or has already plans for getting married in the fall or the new year, this is the time to contact the parish office and make an appointment with one of the priests .

On this Sunday the reading of the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John continues, in which Jesus, after having performed the great miracle of the multiplication of the loaves, explains to the people the meaning of that "sign".

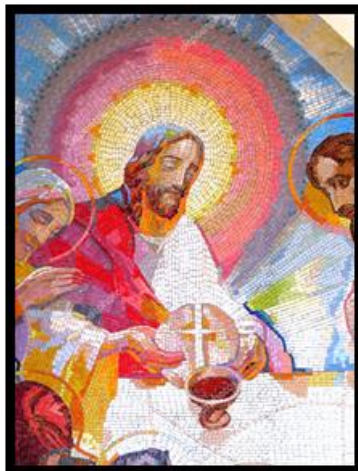
As he had done before with the Samaritan woman, starting from the experience of thirst and the sign of water, here Jesus starts from the experience of hunger and the sign of bread, to reveal Himself and invite us to believe in Him.

People look for Him, people listen to Him, because they were enthusiastic about the miracle and they wanted to make him king! But when Jesus says that the true bread, given by God, is Himself, many are scandalized and do not understand. They begin to murmur among themselves: *"Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does he now say, 'I have come down from heaven'?"* (John 6:42). So Jesus replies: *"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him,"* and adds: *"He who believes has eternal life"* (vs 44 . 47).

It amazes us, and makes us reflect on this word of the Lord because it introduces into the **dynamics of faith - relationship**; that is, the relationship between human persons (all of us) and the Person of Jesus, where the Father plays a decisive role, and naturally also the Holy Spirit (because you cannot separate the Trinity).

We know from the people's encounters with Jesus that it is not enough to meet Jesus face-to-face to believe in Him; it is not enough to read the Bible to believe in Him - the Pharisees and religious elite memorized Scriptures yet rejected

Him. These are important, but not enough! It is not enough even to witness a miracle, like the 5,000 who witnessed the multiplication of the loaves and yet by the next day, *"many of his disciples broke away and would not remain in his company any longer"* (John 6: 66).



Many people have been in close contact with Jesus and did not believe him, indeed, they also despised him and condemned him. *Why?*

When hearts are closed to the action of the Spirit of God, faith does not enter. Jesus tells us that *"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him..."*(v 44). God the Father always draws us to Jesus: it is we who open our hearts or close it. On the other hand, faith, which is like a seed in the depths of the heart, blossoms when we allow ourselves to "draw" from the Father to Jesus. Let us go to Him with an open heart, without resistance, without prejudices and humbling our own wills, then we recognize in His face the Face of God and in His words the Word of God, because the Holy Spirit has made us enter into the relationship of love and life that exists between Jesus and God the Father. And there we receive the gift, the gift of faith.

Then, with this attitude of faith, we can also understand the meaning of the "Bread of Life" that Jesus gives us: *"I am the living bread, come down from heaven. If anyone eats this bread, he will live forever and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world"* (v 55). In Jesus, in his "flesh" - that is, in his concrete humanity - all the love of God, which is the Holy Spirit, is present. Whoever lets himself be attracted by this love goes to Jesus and goes with faith, and receives from Him life - eternal life.

She who lived this experience in an exemplary way is the Virgin of Nazareth, Mary: the first human person who believed in God by accepting the flesh of Jesus. ***Let us learn from you, our Mother, joy and gratitude for the gift of faith. A gift that is not "private", a gift that is not private property but a gift to be shared: it is a gift "for the life of the world"!***

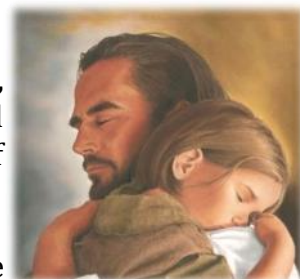
