Dear Parishioners,

The Archbishop's "Statement on the Recent Revelations of Sexual Abuse in the Church" which was read last weekend at all our Masses, is also included in this week's bulletin as a separate insert. It is a call to pray and do penance in reparation for this sinfulness that has harmed so many in the Church over a long period of time, so let us heed the invitation of our Archbishop to do so. The adoration chapel is open 24/7 and you're welcome to use it at any time.

In a few weeks we will be starting our RCIA group again. The letters stand for the "Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults" and is a process spread over several months that intends to introduce people to the Catholic Church by bringing them into the life of the local parish. We are looking for parishioners to help in a variety of ways, either in the role of welcomer, as a sponsor for a candidate, or as a general helper in the working of the program. It's meant to be a parish outreach program. And for the first 8 weeks we will be hosting those interested by conducting an Alpha type presentation that hopefully breaks the ice with those in attendance and leads them into a deeper awareness of the person of Christ and the call to become one of his disciples.

This is an opportunity for some encouraging conversation with family and friends who may have some interest in learning about the Church. The invitation to "come and see" is extended to both those who are familiar with Catholicism to some degree as well as to those who are totally new to the Church and her life of faith. If you are interested in helping as a member of the "crew" please phone the parish office and let us know, and if you are interested in joining the group as a participant please also call the office and sign up.

POPE FRANCIS ~ ANGELUS at Saint Peter's Square

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Today concludes the reading of the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John, with the discourse on the "Bread of Life", pronounced by Jesus in the aftermath of the miracle of the multiplication of loaves and fish. At the end of that speech, the great enthusiasm of the day before died, because Jesus had said that *HE IS the Bread* descended from heaven, and that he would give his flesh as food and his blood as a drink, alluding so clearly to the sacrifice of his life. Those words aroused disappointment in people who judged them unworthy for they looked at Jesus as a Messiah according to their own measure, a Messiah who would speak and act so that his mission would be successful immediately. But they were wrong for they did not understand the mission of the Messiah! Even his disciples could not accept the disquieting language of the Master: *"This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?"* (John 6:60).

In reality, perhaps they understood Jesus' discourse very well, but they do not want to hear it, because it is a discourse that undermines their mentality. Always the words of Jesus put us in crisis, and the Lord knows that our passions and desires are at war within us - *"the flesh is of no avail"* (v.63).

But Jesus offers the key to overcoming the difficulty - a key made of three elements: First, his divine origin: He has descended from heaven and will rise to *"where he was before"* (v.62). Second, his words can be understood only through the action of the Holy Spirit: *"It is the spirit that gives life"* (v.63). It is precisely the Holy Spirit who makes us understand Jesus well. Third, the real cause of the misunderstanding of his words is the lack of faith: *"Among you there are some who do not believe"* (v.64). Yet, Jesus does not discount and does not reduce his words. Instead, he forces us to make a precise choice: either to be with him or separate from him. He says to the Twelve: *"Do you also want to go away?"* (v.67)

At this point Peter makes his confession of faith in the name of the other Apostles: *"Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life"* (v.68). He does not say *"WHERE* will we go?", but instead *"WHO* will we go to?" The basic problem is not to go and abandon the work undertaken, but it is to *WHOM* we go to. From that question of Peter, we understand that fidelity to God is a question of fidelity to a Person - it is not our efforts to moral works or pious ways, but rather to a Person we bind ourselves to, to walk together on the same path. And this person is *Jesus*.

Everything we have in the world does not satisfy our hunger for the infinite. We need Jesus; to be with Him, to feed us at his table, his words of eternal life! Believing in Jesus means making him the center, the meaning of our life. In other words, Christ is not an accessory element! HE is *"living bread"*, indispensable nourishment. Binding ourselves to Him, in a true relationship of faith and love, does not mean being chained, but profoundly free!

Now I will ask you kindly, let us pause for a moment and each of us in silence, in our own hearts, ask ourselves the question: ***Who is Jesus for me?*** Is he an idea or just a historical character? Is he a good teacher on morality that I only acknowledge when I think I am doing well? Is he a just a moral compass that I use to judge others by? Or is He really that person who loves me, who gave his life for me and walks with me? Who is Jesus for you? Are you with Jesus? Are you trying to know him in his word, that is, do you read the Gospel yourself, not just at Sunday Mass, but every day a passage from the Gospel to get to know Jesus? The more we are with Him the more the desire to remain with Him grows.

May the Virgin Mary help us to "go" always to Jesus to experience the freedom that He offers us, and that allows us to clean up our choices from worldly encrustations and fears.

- Why and how do I pray?

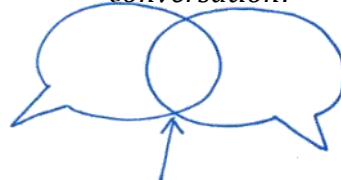
Who is Alpha for? Alpha is for everyone including:

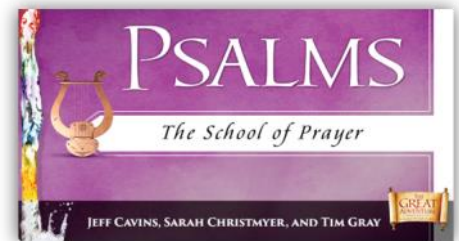
