## Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

This past week I met with the parents of our Confirmation students and shared with them the outline of the program of preparation for this special year in their children's formative lives. One of the things the students do over the next several months is to keep a "Sunday Journal" in which they record the theme of the Gospel text for the Sunday, the main points of the reading, and something of what the priest said in his homily. I encourage the students to bring a notepad with them and to jot down points while they listen, so please don't think they are being disrespectful, they are simply paying closer attention, and that's a good thing for sure.

There are other aspects of the Confirmation program that our families are involved in, and one of them is what we call the "Service Projects" whereby the young people perform some acts of service for the good of their families, their parish, and their community, and all without being paid to do so. Their service is born out of a love for God and for others, and they are being encouraged to put their energy and talents at the service of those beyond themselves. So we wish them well in their journey to the Sacrament of Confirmation, and we offer them our prayerful support in all their preparations.

Next weekend we will have two religious sisters visiting us from the country of Belarus and they will bring with them a variety of homemade religious articles that they make and sell in support of their convent. This may be something you can use for your Christmas gift list for this year, or for some other special occasion like Confirmation or First Holy Communion. The sisters are from the Sisterhood of St. Elizabeth Convent in the Diocese of Minsk and are visiting several parishes in Canada to share the life and ministry of their community and offer their goods in order to raise support for the work they do.

HOMILY OF THE HOLY FATHER FRANCIS ~ Vatican Basilica

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Sunday's biblical readings focus on three topics: the drama of solitude, the love between man and woman and the family.

Adam, as we read in the first Reading, lived in Paradise, imposed the names of other creatures exercising a dominion that demonstrates his indisputable and incomparable superiority, but nevertheless he experienced loneliness, because "*for Adam, no suitable helper was found*" (Genesis 2:20).

Loneliness afflicts so many men and women today. I think of the elderly - abandoned even by their loved ones and their children; to widows and widowers; to the many men and women left behind by their wife or husband; to migrants and refugees who flee from wars and persecutions; and to the many young victims of the culture of consumerism, of disposable goods and of the culture of waste.

Today we experience the paradox of a globalized world where we see so many luxurious houses and skyscrapers, but less and less the warmth of the home and family; so many ambitious projects, but little time to live what has been achieved; many sophisticated means of entertainment, but more and more a deep emptiness in the heart; many pleasures, but little love; so much freedom, but little autonomy... There are more and more people who feel lonely which is ironic given that we live in a time of being connected every moment by our smartphones. And also there are those who are closed in selfishness, melancholy, destructive violence, and the slavery to pleasure and the god of money.

So, in a certain sense, today we live the same experience of Adam who had so much power accompanied by so much solitude and vulnerability; and the family is its icon. Less and less seriousness in carrying forward a solid and fruitful relationship of love: in health and in sickness, in wealth and in poverty, in good and in bad fortune. That kind of covenantal faithfulness is more and more mocked and looked as if it were the stuff of antiquity. And yet, it would seem that the most advanced societies are

those with the lowest birth rate and the highest percentage of abortion, divorce, suicide and environmental and social pollution.

We read again in the first Reading that the heart of God was grieved in seeing the solitude of Adam and said: "*It is not good for man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him*" (Genesis 2:18). These words show that nothing makes the heart of man happy like a heart that resembles it, that corresponds to it and that loves it. These words also show that God did not create you and I to live in sadness or to be lonely; rather He created us for relationship, for happiness, and to live the marvelous experience of love - that is, to love and to be loved. And as today's Psalm proclaims, to see his fruitful love in children.

Here is God's design for his beloved creature: to see it realized in the union of love between man and woman; happy in the common journey, fruitful in mutual giving. It is the same design that Jesus in today's Gospel summarizes when he is faced with a rhetorical question by the Pharisees who came again to test him: "*Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?*" But Jesus responds in a candid and unexpected way with these words: "*From the beginning of creation God made them male and female; for this reason the man will leave his father and his mother and be united with his wife and the two will become one flesh. So they are no longer two, but one*" (Mark 10: 6-8).

Jesus teaches us that at the origin of creation, this is God's design, that He blesses human love. It is He who unites the hearts of a man and a woman who love and unites them in unity and indissolubility. This is what he intended covenantal love to look like. This means that the goal of married life is not only to live together forever, but to love each other forever! Did you hear it? God's design for marriage, God's plan, God's design is that two would become one flesh, and that would create an unbreakable bond, a ferocious commitment to one another that is going to mirror God's covenant with His people. Jesus thus re-establishes the original and originating order.

It is an exhortation to believers to overcome all forms of individualism and legalism, which conceal a narrow selfishness and a fear of adhering to the authentic meaning of the couple and of human sexuality in God's plan.

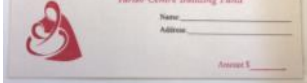

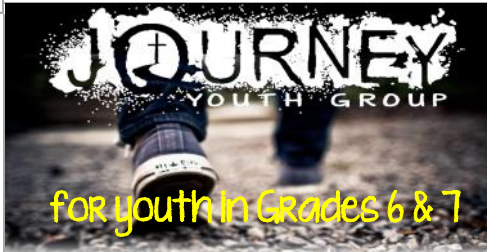

**Vigil Candles**

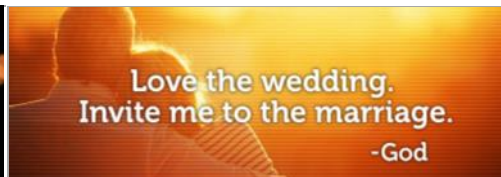
