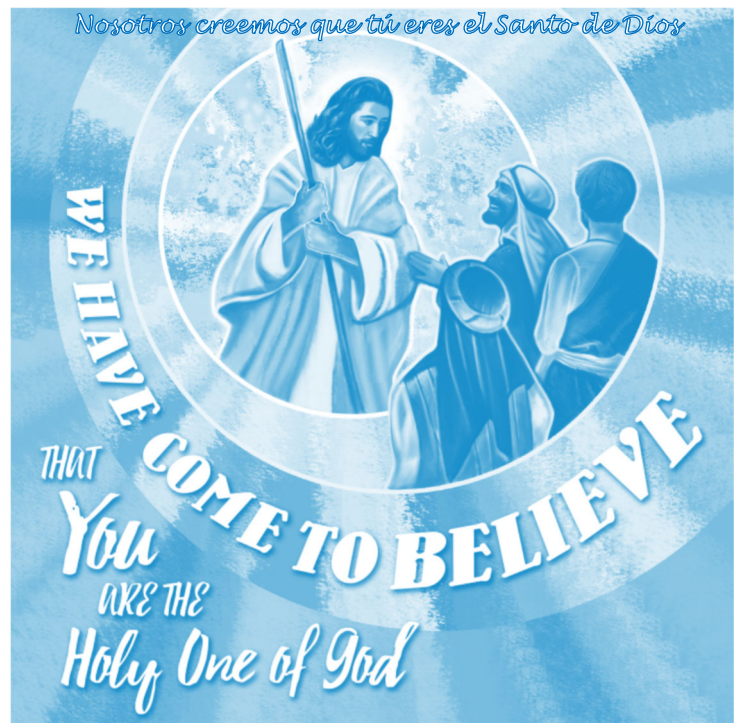
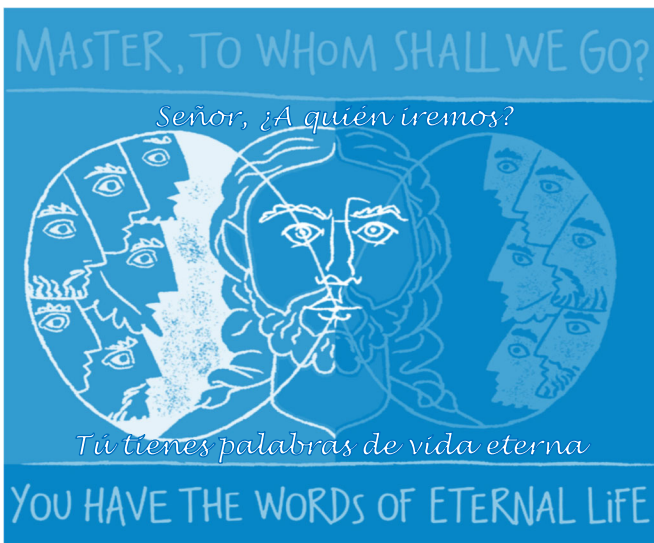

**21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
HOUSEHOLDS IN GOD'S SERVICE**

In the ancient world, "household" was a wide-reaching concept. When Joshua today speaks of his household serving the Lord, he meant not just those people who lived inside his walls or those related to him by blood or marriage; he meant slaves or servants and their families, and anyone indebted to him in any way. Even his livestock and other possessions would be consecrated to service of God. In our world, we value allowing individuals their freedom to choose how they live, and wouldn't think of offering our pets to the service of God. But, as we discern our vocation as disciples baptized into Christ, we can come to realize how far-ranging the "households" of our lives still are: how we act toward our spouses, children, roommates or anyone we live with; our behavior with neighbors; or in public as we encounter many "strangers" every day in stores or traffic who suddenly are "next door" to us. How can we use our time, our resources, or gifts for selfless reasons rather than personal gain? No matter what life our witness to the Good News calls us to, we all have a "household" that must be consecrated to service of the Lord our God.

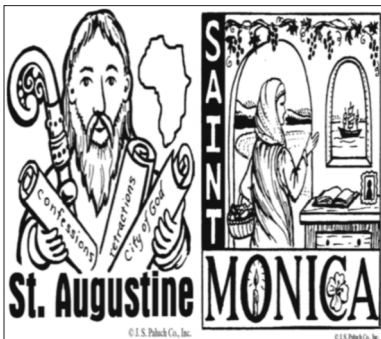

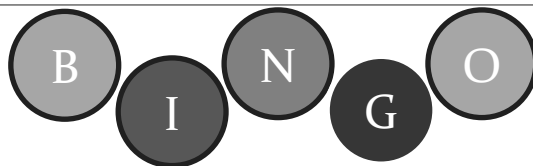

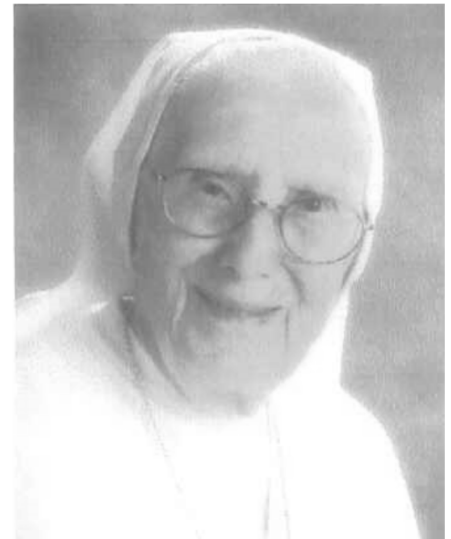
Student Non-Discrimination Policy

Sr. Vittoria Graziani, FMA, a native of Castel Viscardo, Province of Terni, Italy, died peacefully Sunday, August 19, 2018 at Metropolitan Methodist Hospital in San Antonio, TX, just shy of her 100th birthday. She is preceded by her parents, Enrico Graziani and Sofia Peparello, 3 brothers and 6 sisters. She is survived by her nephew Paolo Casali and her niece Sr. Paola Casali, FMA and by numerous grand nieces and nephews. During her 78 years of joyful, missionary, consecrated life, she spent 12 years in missionary formation and evangelizing in Italy, 5 years in New Jersey mastering English and ministering to youth and adults as a catechist. Sr. Vittoria served in leadership roles for 51 years in California, Louisiana, and Texas and for 10 years in Canada where she also mastered the French language. When she could no longer be in active ministry, she lived at the Provincial House in San Antonio, TX where she continued evangelizing by word and example to workers in the house and to all visitors. Her community and all the Salesian Sisters will miss her for her pious demeanor and witty conversations.

Visitation was held last Tuesday, August 21, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. at the Salesian Sisters' Provincial House, 6019 Buena Vista St. in San Antonio, TX with the Rosary at 7:00 p.m. The Mass of the Resurrection was last Wednesday, August 22, 2018 at 10 a.m. at the Provincial House. Interment at San Fernando Cemetery No. 2 in San Antonio.

As a family, you should have a list of family emergency phone numbers that your children know from an early age. Review these numbers together a few times a year. For little children who cannot memorize all that yet, try writing the parents' phone numbers inside their shoes.
