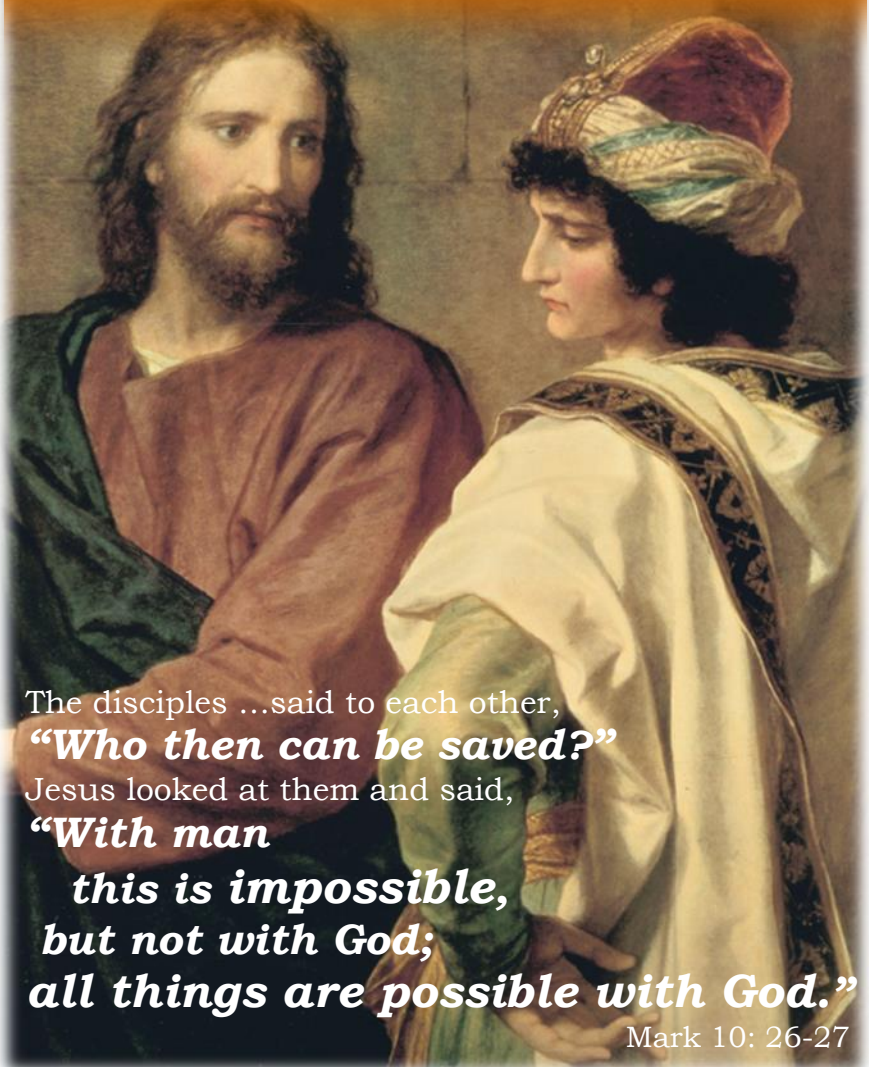

This Sunday's Mass Readings

1ST READING: Wisdom 7:7-11
RESPONSORIAL: Psalm 90: 12-17
2ND READING: Hebrews 4: 12-13
GOSPEL: Mark 10: 17-30

excerpts taken from reflection by Fr. Roger J. Landry, Church of the Holy Family, Manhattan - Oct 10 2015 catholicpreaching.com

Today's Gospel is of Jesus' encounter with the rich young man. He is a good man who has kept the commandments of God, and was concerned about the deepest and most important questions, like the one he asked Jesus, "*What good must I do to inherit eternal life?*" (Mark 10:17) In coming to Jesus as a "good teacher" we already know that he had some faith in Jesus, whose whole bearing intrigued him to approach and ask about the way he should live in order to live forever. He also recognized that, despite all his material wealth, despite even his moral goodness, his heart yearned for something more. He grasped that the life God intended for us had to consist in so much more than merely moral living. And so he asked in St. Matthew's account of the same scene, "*What do I lack?*" (Matthew 19:20)

Jesus' response is: "*You lack one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.*" It was a highly paradoxical answer. What he lacked was precisely that he had too much! He lacked total detachment from substitutes so that he could attach himself to the Absolute. Jesus is saying: "*One thing you still lack; let me reveal to you what it is.*" He uses this man's love for money and the security he has put in money to **expose what really is at the core of his heart**. And because Jesus knows the man's response, He knows the man's heart, He knows the man will not do this. "*When the man heard this... he went away grieving, for he had many possessions.*" (Mark 10:22)

Jesus then says to his disciples, "*How hard it will be for those who have wealth to enter the Kingdom of God.*" There are many reasons that this is true, because rich people have the means to distract themselves in ways poor people do not... When they're lonely, when they feel afraid, rich people could easily go on a vacation or buy a new trinket... and a new car, a fancy vacation, new toys have an amazing amount of power to make things better for a little bit, don't they?

There's a temptation for us to look at this episode exclusively in terms of material possessions. When the rich young man was confronted with the choice between his stuff and Jesus, between continuing to call

his own shots or following the Lord, between the good life that he had and the great one to which Jesus was calling him, the rich young man chose the former.

This is not easy! Like the rich young man, all of us at some point are tempted to try to water God's calling down, to blunt its immediacy, to soften its summons. The devil wants to tempt us in this path by trying to substitute a worldly wisdom for God's, to convince us is that all God wants of us is 60 minutes on a Sunday morning, or to be content with just identifying as a Christian with no real impact on how we live our lives, no real transformation of the heart, to love Him a little rather than to love Him with all — 100% — of our mind, heart, soul and strength. We are seduced into thinking that if we give a dollar to a homeless person everything is fine in our relationship with God, when Jesus is calling us to love others as He has loved us, to sacrifice ourselves just like Jesus who never held anything back out of love for us.

The Lord is always asking you and I to let go of many of His gifts in order to help us to recognize that the greatest gift of all is the Giver. He's regularly asking us to lose our life so as to save it, to go the path of the grain of wheat, falling to the ground and dying, in order to become truly fruitful.

In today's epistle, we read that the "*word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword.*" (Hebrews 4:12) It has the ability to find the dividing point between soul and spirit, joints and marrow. To discern the reflections and thoughts not just of the mind but of the heart, what we really desire and love most. **The word of God is like a mirror**, St. James says, to help us to see who we really are so that we can then **turn to God for the help He knows we need to become whom he created us to be.**

God wishes us all to become perfect, to become *teleios*, the Greek word that means **fit for why we've been made, as His beloved sons and daughters**. But rather than impose His will on us, He proposes His will to our will. His heart speaks to our heart. We approach Him who is good, admit to Him that we're not yet who we want to be, whom we know He wants us to be, that we are not yet fulfilled in our relationship with him, and we ask him "*What do I lack?*" And he will help us to divest ourselves of our attachments so that **we can cling to Him in love and trust.**

Regardless of what happened in the past, the Church invites you to bring new meaning to your lives by embracing the vocation of marriage and dedicating your family's mission to sharing God's love. Please make an appointment with one of our priests to discuss having your marriage convalidated, or "blessed".

Hospital / Care Home Communion Visits Please remember to let the Parish Office know whenever you or a loved one is hospitalized or moves into a care home in our community. The Parish has a dedicated group of people who will bring Holy Communion weekly to you or yours.

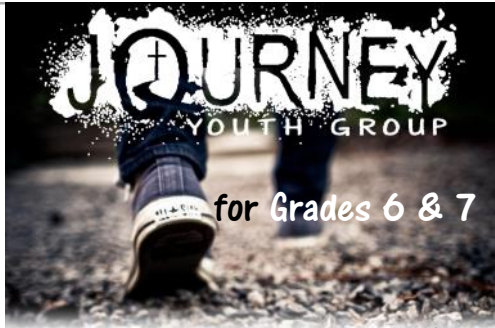
