## SEPTEMBER MEMO

### Dear Pastors, Principals and Parish Leadership Teams,

The revelations of the Grand Jury in Pennsylvania about decades of clergy sexual abuse and cover up including the accusations within our Church leadership have rocked the faith of many of our parishioners. Statements are one thing, but our people are demanding action. As bishops and others work on revised policies for accountability, there are many things that we can do as local communities. The Archdiocese has made great strides in developing programs and policies for the protection of both children and other vulnerable people. Although we cannot predict or prevent all abuse, the abuse prevention efforts that have been established in the Safeguard the Children Office and otherwise are helping to mitigate the effects of abuse by reporting abuse to authorities, removing those found to have abused minors from ministry and reaching out to victims to support them through the healing process. We continue to dedicate ourselves to this work and to sharing what we have learned with others in our community.

We must be mindful of the pain these revelations are causing for survivors of abuse and their families. They may be attending services or meetings in our parishes, schools and ministries suffering in silence. Our Victim's Assistance Ministry office has worked consistently to assist survivors of abuse and to educate our faithful. We must continue to support these very important ministries and to especially help everyone to reach out to those who are suffering or impacted by abuse by inviting them to call upon our victim's assistance resources for support and help. Abuse is an extremely sad and difficult reality of all sectors of our society, but we must stand together to do all we can to help prevent it and help and support those who have been harmed.

I want to thank you for speaking to your parishioners openly about this matter. I have heard that many of you already addressed it in either a homily or after Mass. You are also taking great effort to make sure you have safe environments in your parishes/schools. We must continue these efforts and outreach on an ongoing basis as our people need to know about these efforts and on-going resources.

The Archdiocese is urging that throughout the Archdiocese we unite in action and prayer, in communion with the dioceses of Pennsylvania and the others impacted by the most recent developments. I urge you to join in a special weekend of prayer, penance, purification and healing centered on the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, September 15-16. Following are suggestions from the Archdiocese for liturgical and other activities. I invite you to use these or develop-and share-- others that are suited to your parish/school community .

Again, I want to thank you for your work in our parishes. May Jesus the Healer touch us and bring us courage and hope, and may our Lady of Sorrows intercede for us.

**TWENTY-EIGHT SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

The spirit of wisdom, as we discover in today's first reading, comes to those who pray for her. Wisdom, like the word of God, carries a message of consolation as well as of great challenge. The Letter to the Hebrews tells us that the word of God, infused with the wisdom of God, is "sharper than any two-edged sword." We cannot shrink from the wisdom of God, or from the word that has the power to penetrate our hearts and minds. Jesus, the living word of God, the embodiment of wisdom, has strong, deeply penetrating words for the rich young man who comes to him seeking answers to his most profound questions. Just when the young man thought he had done enough to fulfill God's commands, more was asked of him. This is no less true for us.

Please drop off a copy of your current certificate to the Office; if your certificate had expired, it is your obligation to find the soonest scheduled class to take it and comply with this utmost urgent matter.

We are under very strict scrutiny to comply with the archdiocesan policies adopted under the Charter for the Protection of Minors established by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and its annual compliance audit. Classes are offered continually at various parishes on a rotating basis.
