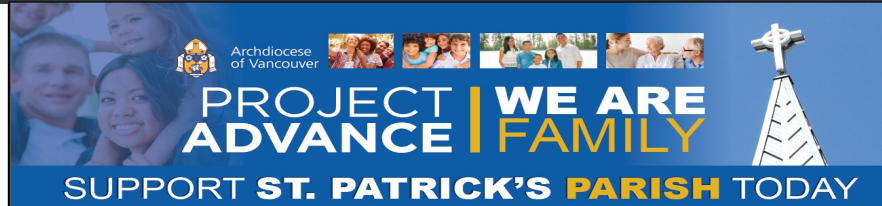

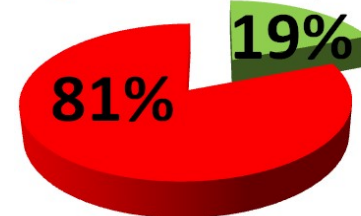


PROJECT ADVANCE THANK-YOU: WEEK 25

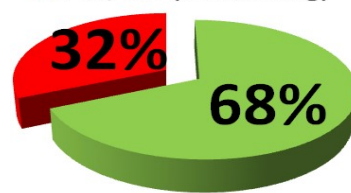
Family Participation Meter (%)

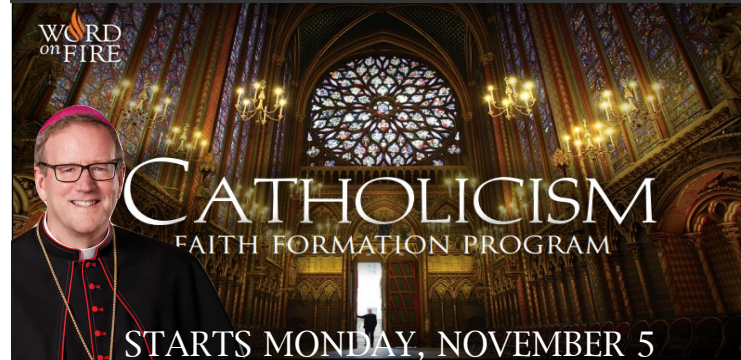

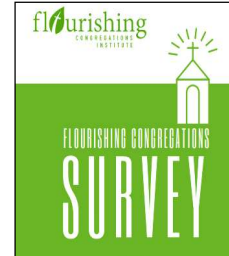
