### From the Pastor's Desk

Last Friday evening we had a "Listening and Praying" session in response to the recent and ongoing reports on sexual abuse, and the handling of it, in the Church.

It was painful and heavy with much pain, disillusion, anger, and frustration expressed. We did one room in English and another in Spanish and then we all joined for song and prayer at the end and I found it good to bring all that pain to prayer.

On the weekend we had a Light of the World retreat in Spanish and it was a wonderful work of the Spirit, with great confessions, healings, burdens long carried laid down and sadness turned to joy as the Scripture often describes the effect of God's action.

In those two experiences, I found the two sides of the Church, one of pain, scandal, the sad human reality of sin and its tragic consequences; the other a Church that can bring forgiveness, healing, peace, community, and service in such a powerful way.

I used a quote from *Carlo Carretto*, a big name when I was a student (he went to be a hermit in North Africa and wrote some extraordinary spiritual books) which catches well this ambivalence:

*How much I must criticize you, my church and yet how much I love you!*

*How you have made me suffer much and yet owe much to you. I should like to see you destroyed and yet I need your presence. You have given me much scandal and yet you alone have made me understand holiness.*

*Never in this world have I seen anything more obscurantist, more compromised, more false, and yet never in this world have I touched anything more pure, more generous, and more beautiful. Many times I have felt like slamming the door of my soul in your face – and yet how often I have prayed that I might die in your sure arms!*

*No, I cannot be free of you, for I am one with you, even though not completely you. Then, too – where would I go? To build another church? But I cannot build another without the same defects, for they are my own defeats I bear within me.*

*And again, if I build one, it will be my Church, and no longer Christ's. No, I am old enough to know that I am no better than others.*

*I shall not leave this Church, founded on so frail a rock, because I should be founding another one on an even frailer rock: myself. And then, what do rocks matter? What matters is Christ's promise, what matters is the cement that binds the rocks into one: the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit alone can build the Church with stones as ill-hewn as we.*

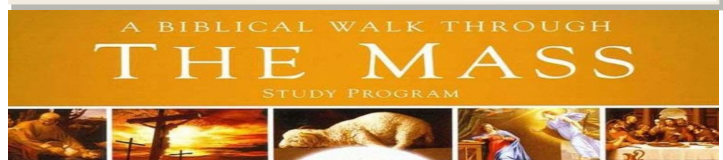

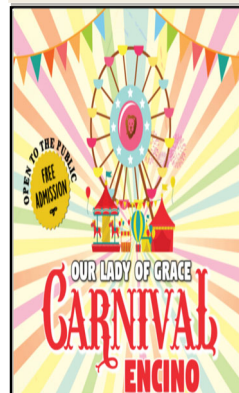

## Mensaje del Párroco

El pasado viernes por la noche tuvimos una sesión en respuesta a los informes recientes y en curso sobre el abuso sexual y el manejo de la misma, en la Iglesia. Fue doloroso y pesado con mucho dolor, la desilusión, la ira y la frustración expresadas. Hicimos un grupo en inglés y otro en español y luego todos se reunieron para alabanza y oración al final y me pareció bueno que pudimos elevar todo ese dolor en la oración.

El fin de semana tuvimos nuestro retiro de Luz del Mundo y fue una obra maravillosa del Espíritu, con grandes momentos de confesiones, y sanación de cargas de mucho tiempo. Ver que la tristeza pasa a la alegría como la Escritura a menudo se describe el efecto de la acción de Dios.

En esas dos experiencias me encontré con los dos lados de la Iglesia, uno de dolor, escándalo, la realidad humana tristeza del pecado y sus consecuencias trágicas; la otra, una Iglesia que puede traer el perdón, la sanación y la paz, la comunidad y el servicio de una manera tan poderosa.

He utilizado una cita de Carlo Carretto, un gran nombre cuando yo era estudiante (que fue a ser un ermitaño en el norte de África y escribió algunos libros espirituales extraordinarios) que atrapa bien esta ambivalencia:

*¿Cuánto tengo que criticar a mi iglesia y sin embargo lo mucho que te encanta!*

*Cómo han hecho sufrir mucho y sin embargo debo mucho a ti. Quisiera verte destruida y sin embargo, necesito su presencia.*

*Me has dado mucho escándalo y sin embargo solo me has hecho comprender la santidad. Nunca en este mundo he visto que sólo algo más oscurantista, más comprometida, más falso, y sin embargo nunca en este mundo he tocado nada más puro, más generoso, y más bella.*

*Muchas veces me he sentido como cerrar la puerta de mi alma en su cara - y sin embargo, cuántas veces me han rogado que podría morir en sus brazos seguro! No, no puedo ser libre de ti, porque yo soy uno contigo, aunque no totalmente. Entonces, también - a dónde iría? Para construir otra iglesia?*

*Pero no puedo construir otro sin que los mismos defectos, porque son mis propias derrotas que llevo dentro de mí. Y de nuevo, si construyo uno, será mi Iglesia, y ya no la de Cristo. No, no soy lo suficientemente mayor para saber que no soy mejor que otros.*

*No voy a salir de esta Iglesia, fundada sobre una roca tan frágil, ya que debería estar fundando otro en una roca aún más frágil: yo mismo.*

*Y entonces, ¿qué importan las rocas?*

*Lo que importa es la promesa de Cristo, lo que importa es el cemento que une las rocas en una sola: el Espíritu Santo. El Espíritu Santo puede construir la Iglesia con piedras mal obradas como nosotros.*
