From the Desk of Father Mac,

Every year, something special happens on this next-to-last Sunday of October: **WORLD MISSION SUNDAY**. World Mission Sunday joins all Catholics of the world - all of us children of God - into one community of faith. At Mass this Sunday, we recommit ourselves to our common vocation, through Baptism, to be missionaries, through prayer, participation in the Eucharist, and by giving generously to today's second collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. Special envelopes are in the pew racks.

Pope Pius XI instituted World Mission Sunday in 1926, asking for prayer, animation, celebration, and offerings for the Missions. His concern was to engender a sense of responsibility in people for supporting the Missions throughout the world.

The first commemoration was in 1927 and the Pope asked that it be observed in every diocese, parish and institute. It was to be a true World Mission Sunday. The collection on that first World Mission Sunday, like today, is for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, providing support for the life-giving and hope-filled work and witness of priests, religious and lay pastoral leaders in mission churches.

Pope Francis describes our everyday lives as children of God as a grand adventure. What a wonderful way to imagine the mission we have received from the Lord! It is a revitalizing adventure. When all the children of God, at every stage of life, reflect on the fact that our lives are a mission, our faith remains ever young.

As we pray and respond on World Mission Sunday here at home, we share in those celebrations taking place in every parish, seminary, school and convent all over the world. Together with children of God in every corner of the globe, we become voices for mission, providing the prayerful and financial support necessary to bring the Lord's mercy and concrete help to the most vulnerable communities in the Pope's missions.

In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as children of God, His missionaries! And it provides an opportunity to support the life-giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized.

Thank you for your support of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith on this World Mission Sunday, making it possible for priests, religious Sisters and Brothers, and lay pastoral leaders to reach out, in the name of Jesus, to families and communities in need in over 1,111 mission dioceses.

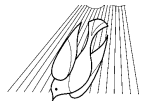

BE A TRUSTED RESOURCE IF A CHILD DISCLOSES ABUSE



Parents are in a unique position to know about not only their own children, but their children's friends. If you are a trusted parent, your child's friend may come to you with secrets. What do you do if a child tells you about abuse? As an adult, it's critical that you remain calm, and don't overreact. Child victims are often frightened and confused, and your confusion and anger does not help their situation. Your concern and support, however, will affirm the child in important ways and can help begin the healing process for a child victim who has suffered at the hands of a predator. PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN™ VIRTUS PROGRAM is a three hour training that educates clergy, staff and volunteers on how to identify the warning signs of abuse. It is mandated training for all adults who work with or around children or teens. This session also stresses monitoring of computers, cell phones and other technology that perpetrators use to gain access to children and young people. The Virtus certification is valid for four years. Recertification is required if you are an active volunteer or employed by the Los Angeles Archdiocese.
