From the Pastor's Desk

Each year in November, we review our stewardship of the financial resources in the parish. This week our finance council presents a report on the past fiscal year and over the upcoming weeks, we will prayerfully review our own contribution to those resources. Presenting a financial report is always a balance between too little detail and too much to be easily digestible. I am grateful to our Finance Council for preparing the report and presenting it. We will be happy to provide any more information or detail that anybody wants. Our weekly collections stayed about the same as last year, and increased rental income helped us to balance our budget. Personnel changes and less than expected capital expenses accounted for a decrease in spending.

This report takes us up to the end of June. The early months of this fiscal year, since July 1st, show a significant decrease in offertory income which I take to be an effect of the ongoing reports of scandals in the Church. If that trend continues I fear it will lead to a decrease in our ministries and evangelization efforts here at OLG.

Thanks to all whose contributions make possible all our ministry and service here. The Finance Council represents the community and is committed to the oversight of expenditures and good financial business practices. I take this opportunity to thank the current members: Julianne Cruz (president), Rowena Morneau (secretary), Jesus Lopez, Keith Handley, Robert Slater, Kevin Schaffels, Faith Frugoli and Robert Hubbell.

Gospel: Mk 12: 28 B-34



In the course of his teaching Jesus said to the crowds, "Beware of the scribes, who like to go around in long robes and accept greetings in the marketplaces, seats of honor in synagogues, and places of honor at banquets. They devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext recite lengthy prayers. They will receive a very severe condemnation." He sat down opposite the treasury and observed how the crowd put money into the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents. Calling his disciples to himself, he said to them, "Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood."

Mensaje del Párroco

Cada año en el mes de noviembre, revisamos nuestra administración de los recursos financieros de la parroquia. Esta semana, nuestro consejo de finanzas presentara un informe sobre el año fiscal 2017-2018. Durante las próximas semanas, pondremos en oración nuestra propia contribución a esos recursos. Al presentar un informe financiero, siempre tratamos de buscar un balance entre muy pocos detalles y demasiados para poderles presentar esta información de la manera más eficaz. Agradezco a nuestro Consejo de Finanzas por preparar el informe y presentarlo. Ellos y yo estaremos encantados de proporcionar cualquier información o detalle que alguien desee saber referente a este reporte. Nuestras colecciones semanales permanecieron casi igual que el año pasado, y el aumento de los ingresos por alquiler nos ayudó a equilibrar nuestro presupuesto. Los cambios de personal y menos gastos de capital representaron una disminución en el área de gastos.

Este informe nos lleva hasta finales de junio. Los primeros meses de este año fiscal, desde el 1 de julio, muestran una disminución significativa en los ingresos del ofertorio, lo que considero un efecto de los informes continuos de escándalos en la Iglesia. Si esa tendencia continúa, me temo que conducirá a una disminución en nuestros ministerios y esfuerzos de evangelización aquí en nuestra parroquia.

Les agradezco a todos aquellos cuyas contribuciones hacen posible todo nuestro ministerio y servicio aquí. El Consejo de Finanzas representa a la comunidad y está comprometido a la supervisión de los gastos y las buenas prácticas comerciales financieras. Aprovecho esta oportunidad para agradecer a los miembros actuales: Julianne Cruz (presidenta), Rowena Morneau (secretaria), Jesús López, Keith Handley, Robert Slater, Kevin Schaffels, Faith Frugoli y Robert Hubbell.

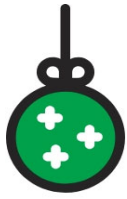
