# This Sunday's Mass Readings

**1ST READING:** Daniel 12:1-3

POPE FRANCIS' ANGELUS ~ Saint Peter's Square

Sunday, November 15th 2015

The Gospel of this penultimate Sunday of the liturgical year proposes a part of the discourse of Jesus on the last events of human history, oriented towards the full fulfillment of the kingdom of God (Mk 13: 24-32). It is a speech that Jesus made in Jerusalem, before his last Easter. It contains some apocalyptic elements, such as wars, famines, cosmic catastrophes: "The sun will darken, the moon will no longer give its light, the stars will fall from the sky and the powers that are in the heavens will be shaken" (v. 24-25). However these elements are not the essential thing of the message. The central nucleus around which Jesus' discourse turns is Himself, the mystery of his person and of his death and resurrection, and his return at the end of time.

Our final goal is the meeting with the risen Lord. And I would like to ask you: how many of you think of this? There will be a day when I will meet the Lord face to face. This is our goal: this meeting. We do not wait for a time or a place, but let's meet a person: Jesus. Therefore, the problem is not "when" the warning signs of the last times will happen, but to be ready for the meeting. And it is not even about knowing "how" these things will happen, but "how" we must behave, today, waiting for them. We are called to live the present, building our future with serenity and trust in God. The parable of the fig tree that sprouts, as a sign of the near summer (v. 28-29), says that the prospect of the end does not distract us from the present life, but it makes us look at our days from a perspective of hope. It is that virtue so difficult to live: hope, the smallest of the virtues, but the strongest. And our hope has a face: the face of the risen Lord, who comes "with great power and glory" (v.26), that is, he manifests his crucified love transfigured in the resurrection. The Lord Jesus is not only the point of arrival of the earthly pilgrimage, but it is a constant presence in our life: it is always beside us, it always accompanies us; for this when he speaks of the future, and projects us towards it, it is always to bring us back to the present. He stands against false prophets, against the seers who foresee near the end of the world, and against fatalism. He is next to us, he walks with us, he loves us. He wants to subtract his disciples of every age from curiosity for dates, forecasts, horoscopes, and focuses our attention on the today of history. I would like to ask you - but do not answer, everyone answers inside -: how many of you read the horoscope of the day? Everyone answers. And when you want to read the horoscope, look to Jesus, who is with you. It's better, it will do you better.

Even in our days there is no lack of natural and moral calamities, nor even adversity and misfortune of any kind. Everything passes - the Lord reminds us -; only He, his Word remains as a guiding light, reassures our steps and always forgives us, because it is next to us. It is only necessary to look at it and change our heart. May the Virgin Mary help us to trust in Jesus, the firm foundation of our life, and to persevere with joy in his love.

As Pope Gregory the Great once wrote "He causes his prayers to be of more avail to himself who offers them also for others." In other words, as our Lord said in Luke's Gospel "Give and it shall be given to you" (Luke 6:38). **God cannot be outdone in generosity!**

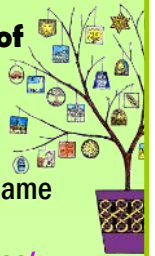

## The Tradition of the Jesse Tree

The Jesse tree represents Jesus' family tree. The name is taken from Isaiah 11:1: *A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots* - Jesus is referred to as a shoot coming up from the stump of Jesse, the father of King David. We adorn a Jesse tree with illustrated ornaments that represent the people, prophecies, and events leading up to the birth of Jesus. The ornaments of the Jesse tree tell the story of God in the Old Testament, connecting the Advent season with the faithfulness of God across 4,000 years of history.

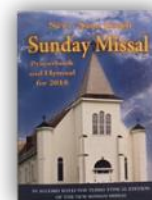

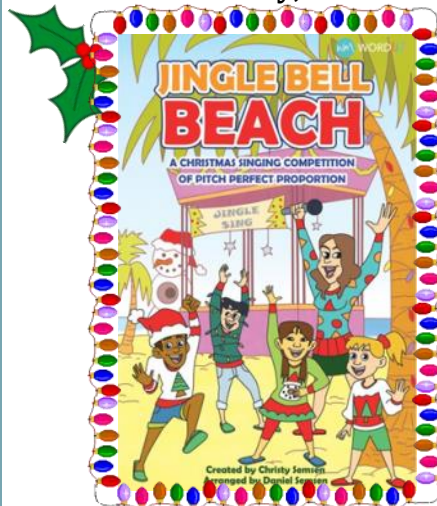
