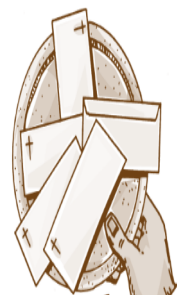

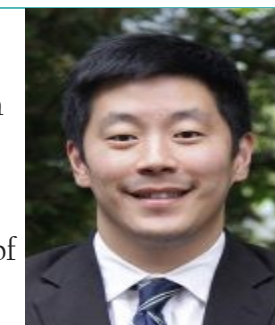

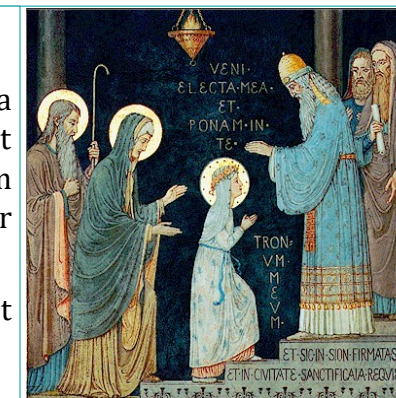


BROTHER FELIX MIN

PRESENTATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY (November 21)

This feast originated as a commemoration of the dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary's the New in Jerusalem in 543. An apocryphal source recounts that Mary's parents brought their three-year-old daughter to the Temple in Jerusalem to offer her to God, as was the custom. Inspired by a priest's vision, they left her there to serve God. This custom continued for centuries.

The Feast entered the Western calendar in 1585. Today, the feast celebrates the recognition of Mary as a temple where God lives.
