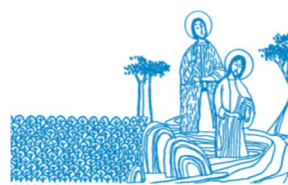

The Baptism of the Lord CALLED TO SERVE

For many weeks now, we have been celebrating the appearance of the divine presence in human form. As a child, he came to Mary and Joseph, was seen by the shepherds, and then by some wandering magi from the East. Today we celebrate another showing, later in time, to a group gathered at the Jordan River.

John hesitated to baptize Jesus, whom he recognized as "one mightier than I." But he did as Jesus asked, and the "Holy Spirit descended" and heaven's voice spoke to Jesus, "You are my beloved Son." Jesus was beginning his public life of teaching and service. Soon he would start calling others to join him.

Peter was one of the first to be called by Jesus. In today's second reading, he announces the heart of the message, "peace through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all." Peter was called, and you and I are called to spread that message and to serve God's word.

Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos

WELCOME NEW CATECHUMENS AND CANDIDATES

Today at the 10:00 & 1:00 Masses, we celebrated one of the rituals that accompany Christian initiation: the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens and Rite of Welcoming Candidates for Full Communion. Matthew Arceo, Sarah Estrada, Adriana Garcia, Jessica Herrera, Lidia Ofagalilo, Lydia Escobedo, Emma Canas and Jonathan Scailoa came to us some months ago, inquiring about Jesus and about how we, who are Roman Catholics, follow him. They have been among us, seen Christ's power, and have begun to be influenced by His grace. His grace led them to today, where we had the privilege of accepting them, embracing them, and formally beginning what will be a lifelong relationship with Christ and the Church. Today, they embraced the cross, and accepted the Sacred Scriptures. Today, they became known to us as catechumens. Prisma Bermúdez, Guadalupe Márquez, José Méndez, Leticia Miranda, Kevin Pinzón, Michelle Pinzón and Andy Urive were also with us today at the 1:00 Mass. Each of them have already been baptized and seek to come into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. We welcomed them today, recalling their baptism, and reminding them that Christ is known through the Scriptures and the Tradition.

From this day on, until they complete their preparation and are called to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist or just Confirmation and Eucharist, we will walk with them, sharing our liturgies, our Tradition, our works of charity and justice, and our life in community.

What is the RCIA Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens?

The Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens is for inquirers in the RCIA process who are preparing for their Baptism. They are now ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey towards becoming Catholics. At this Rite, they are asked to more fully embrace the Gospel message with the help of God, and are also signed with the Cross to show that they now belong to Christ, the Shepherd of souls. In this Rite, the parish community has the opportunity to more fully participate in and pray for those in the RCIA process. This Rite places these catechumens in a formal relationship with the universal Church.

What is the RCIA Rite of Welcoming?

The Rite of Welcoming is for inquirers who have been previously baptized and are ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey toward full communion with the Catholic Church. At this Rite, they are asked if they are ready to listen to the apostles' instruction, gather with the worshipping community in prayer, and join that community in the love and service of others. They are signed with the Cross to show that they belong to Christ.

Why is the parish community important at the Rites of Acceptance and Welcoming?

Members of the parish community should affirm that they are ready to help and support the RCIA candidates seeking to follow Christ. We ask you to please pray for them as they continue their conversion journey and for our RCIA process as we assist them in moving toward a closer relationship with God. Your prayers are critical to the success of our program. We will continue to keep you informed of the initiation process and progress of those considering joining the Church. We invite you to take an active role in welcoming our soon-to-be catechumens and candidates, and to be models of faith and Christian charity for them. We look forward to the time when the Catechumens and Candidates will fully participate in the sharing of the Lord's Table.

BIENVENIDOS A LOS NUEVOS CATECUMENOS Y CANDIDATOS

Hoy en la misa de 10:00 a.m. y 1 p.m., celebramos uno de los rituales que acompañan la iniciación cristiana: El Rito de Aceptación en la Orden de Catecúmenos y Rito de Bienvenida a Candidatos para su Comunión completa. Lydia Escobedo, Emma Canas, Jonathan Scailola, Matthew Arceo, Sarah Estrada, Adriana Garcia, Jessica Herrera y Lidia Ofagalilo llegaron hace algunos meses, preguntando sobre Jesús y como, nosotros que somos Católicos romanos, lo seguimos. Y que ahora están listos para declarar públicamente su intención de continuar su camino hacia su conversión como Católicos. En este Rito, se les pide que abracen más plenamente el mensaje del Evangelio con la ayuda de Dios, y también están sellados con la Cruz para mostrar que ahora pertenecen a Cristo, el Pastor de las almas. En este Rito, la comunidad parroquial tiene la oportunidad de participar más y orar por aquellos en el proceso de RCIA. Este Rito coloca a estos catecúmenos en una relación formal con la Iglesia universal.

¿Qué es el rito de Bienvenida de R.I.C.A.?

El Rito de Bienvenida es para los que han sido previamente bautizados y están listos para declarar públicamente su intención de continuar su camino hacia la plena comunión con la Iglesia Católica. En este Rito, se les pregunta si están listos para escuchar la instrucción de los apóstoles, reunirse con la comunidad de adoración en la oración, y unirse a esa comunidad en el amor y el servicio de los demás. Estarán sellados con la Cruz para mostrar que pertenecen a Cristo.

¿Por qué es importante la comunidad parroquial en los Ritos de Aceptación y Bienvenida?

Los miembros de la comunidad parroquial deben afirmar que están dispuestos a ayudar y apoyar a los candidatos de R.I.C.A. que buscan seguir a Cristo. Les pedimos que oren por ellos mientras continúan su viaje de conversión y para nuestro proceso de RCIA mientras les ayudamos a avanzar hacia una relación más cercana con Dios. Sus oraciones son fundamentales para el éxito de nuestro programa. Continuaremos manteniéndolos informados sobre el proceso de iniciación y progreso de aquellos que consideran unirse a la Iglesia. Les invitamos a tomar un papel activo en dar la bienvenida a nuestros catecúmenos y candidatos, y ser modelos de fe y caridad cristiana para ellos. 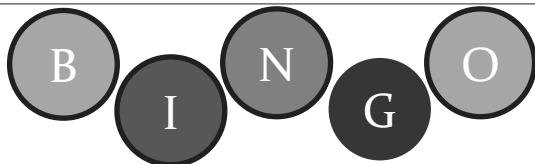
